## Preschool:

### Three-Year-Old Classes:

We have three options for three-year-old students: they meet from September through May for 2 ¾ hours a day. There is a maximum of 9 children and a minimum of 2 teachers per class. Children must be three-years-old by September 1st of the school year in which they attend. Three-year-olds have the choice of two-, three-, or four-day programs.

### Pre-K Classes:

We have four options for our Pre-K students: Option 1 is our traditional 4-day or 5 day 2 ¾ hrs. class. Option 2 is the extended program which runs daily from 9:00-1:30. Option 3 is an afternoon class which runs daily from 12:30-3:00. Option 4 is a full day Pre-K class which runs daily from 9:00 to 3:00, students will bring their lunch and stay the whole day.

### Ala carte programs:

Early drop off (starts at 8:00 am)

Lunch Bunch (bring a lunch, pick up at 12:45)

Enrichment classes (include lunch bunch, pick up at 2:00)

Extended Day (designed for classes that end at 1:30, pick up at 3:00)

## Kindergarten:

Individual attention and appreciation for our students ensures each will find their best way of solidly learning all the fundamentals. We focus on each child's strengths and aim to meet their educational and social needs. Space is limited!

### Kindergarten Program:

5 Day (8:40 – 1:30) M-F

Kindergarten classes meet from September until the beginning of June for approximately 5 hours a day.
